## **Auditioning at DIME**

All students are required to pass an audition to attend the MSU Denver at DIME program. As part of this audition, applicants will be interviewed about their previous experience and training. Additionally, they will be asked to perform two songs either to a backing track or self-accompanied on an instrument, and perform scales and exercises as requested by the assessor.

#### **Admission to MSU Denver**

All students will be asked to formally apply and submit all necessary documents to Metropolitan State University of Denver through their online application portal. The online application is available at: <a href="https://www.msudenver.edu/admissions/apply">www.msudenver.edu/admissions/apply</a>

**Transfer students** are welcome to apply, but should be aware that the program is cohort based and will require a four-year commitment.

### Tuition, Financial Aid, Scholarships, and Work-Study

Tuition for students on the MSU Denver at DIME program is \$14,625 for the 18/19 academic year. Financial Aid and Scholarships are available. Students are highly encouraged to fill out a FAFSA by April 1st, and apply for scholarships no later than March 1st. DIME Detroit also now offers work study to incoming students. If approved, students can earn up to \$3,000 per semester.

DIME has become a center for performers, songwriters, and music entrepreneurs, and with that comes many opportunities for our growing student body. Our students receive several **performance opportunities** that include end-of-semester student showcases at our on-site music venue, **The Underground @ DIME**, as well as opportunities to perform at events in the Detroit area. Also, students are able to audition and perform alongside well-known musicians through our **masterclass program**.

MSU Denver at DIME Students can consult any instructor about various aspects of their developing musical careers through our **one-to-one system**, which includes a yearly **career action planning tutorial**. Each week, students have access to sessions that focus on subjects like networking, professional development, self-employment skills, and more.

Students have the opportunity to audition original material for DIME's annual student album, **DIME Sessions**, which is recorded and released through the school's affiliate record label, **Original 1265 Recordings**.
