- 3. Student Information form and release
- 4. Essay answers as indicated.

Here are some tips to help with your application:

- 1. Be sure you have completed all of the necessary forms including the FAFSA application and any other financial aid applications.
- 2. Take time to write a thoughtful and compelling essay. The essay is your chance for advisors to hear your voice, understand your entrepreneurial vision and make your application stand out.
- 3. Before you begin, outline your essay. Be sure to include a clear, concise and powerful statement that expresses the theme of your essay.
- 4. Be honest and promote your strengths as a leader or entrepreneur.
- 5. Do not exceed the word limit and carefully proofread your essay. Use the resources available through DIME to help you polish your essay. This includes the DIME Advisory Committee and your fellow classmates.
